



Minnesota Republican Party Senate District 47 Convention Resolutions



Therefore, be it resolved that...

➤ Section 1 - Promote Economic Prosperity

➤ Section 2 - Preserving Our Civil Rights

- (1) The Republican Party of Minnesota calls for an overturning of all legislation passed by the DFL party in 2023 that opposes our party's platform for life; and the GOP will back taxpayer funding of programs that support women who are in crisis pregnancy.
- (2) We support truth & reality, nature and biology in all of our policies and practices.

Therefore, we oppose any legislation that requires citizens to affirm a lie, falsehood, or psychological delusion – such as adding “gender identity and gender expression” to the ERA, or the redefining of “sex” in Title IX to include “gender identity.”

- (3) The Republican Party of Minnesota fully supports the constitutional rights of the Church and any Religious organizations to preach/teach messages that are consistent with their religiously held beliefs. Nor may any faith-based organization be required or coerced to preach/teach messages that contradict their religiously held convictions. [Section 2- Protect Religious liberties]
- (4) The MN GOP demands that the Minnesota Legislature pass the ‘Never again’ Bill immediately, regardless of opposition stemming from radically corrupted politicians.

➤ Section 3 - Protect our Health Care

(5) “Let Kids be Kids”

- We support policies to protect the natural development of children's sexuality and biological puberty.
- We support policies that protect children from chemical interference with puberty or surgical mutilation of the body.
- We call for HF146 to be repealed because the evidence proves that “Gender Affirming Care” is profoundly damaging to minors.

(6) Stop mandates for Vaccines. [Section 3 – Improve Quality]

➤ Section 4 - Educate our Children

(7) The Republican Party of Minnesota fully supports the rights of Parents to homeschool their children in a manner that upholds their Constitutional rights and remains free from discriminatory regulation or attempts to impose public school standards or regulations upon them. [Section 4 - Protect Parental Choice]

(8) The Republican Party :

- Supports policies to protect the innocence and sexuality of children both psychologically.
- Supports subjects that have to do with academic learning and not sexual identity.
- Prohibits any sexually explicit or graphic material in K-12 education or in libraries.
- Resolution for HF146 to be repealed.

(9) The Republican Party supports teaching academic achievement versus sexual orientation.

(10) We believe that biological boys shall not compete in biological girls' sports.

(11) The Republican Party:

- Supports policies to protect the innocence and sexuality of children, both physically and psychologically.
- Supports only developmentally age-appropriate materials for minors in public schools and libraries.
- Prohibits any sexually explicit or graphic material in K-12 education or in library's children or youth sections.

(12) "Protect Homeschool Freedom" – The Republican Party of Minnesota fully supports the rights of parents to homeschool their children in a manner that upholds their constitutional rights and remains free from any discriminatory regulation or attempt to impose public school regulations or standards upon them.'

(13) All curriculum revision and standards should be determined and approved by the elected members of the State Legislature, not by the appointed Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board.

➤ Section 5 - Strengthen our Families and Communities

- (14) Strong Families make a Strong Nation! – We will actively seek to create/promote policies that incentivize and support traditional marriage and family, and we will actively oppose tax, welfare and health insurance policies that discriminate against married people.
- (15) We oppose any constitutional amendment, like the proposed version of a “Equal Rights Amendment,” that guarantees abortion up to birth and that excludes conscience and religious freedom protections.

➤ **Section 6 - Protect Public Safety**

- (16) The Minnesota GOP condemns antisemitism in all of its forms, including the targeting of Jews as individuals, as a people, or denial of the right of the State of Israel to exist, and is committed to combatting anti-Jewish bias in all of its manifestations.

➤ **Section 8 - Enjoy and Protect our Natural Resources**

- (17) We support domestic self-sustaining American energy sources over foreign sourced energy. All energy policies/laws must support American energy independence, benefit Americans, and be scientifically backed by solid, achievable science.

➤ **Section 9 - Make Government Smaller and Better**

- (18) Pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States, the Legislature of the State of Minnesota petitions the Congress of the United States of America, to call a convention of the states limited to proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States that 1) impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, 2) limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and 3) limit the terms of office for its officials and for members of Congress.
- (19) We support local control of election data and processes through: city-established precincts of <2,000 registered voters and corresponding polling locations; city management of election judge hiring, training, scheduling, operations, payroll, and associated data; establishment of city-managed Ballot Boards and Election Day hand-counting of races and referendums; city-managed Post Election Reviews (PER) sample for all contested races; and county-only control of their residents’ voter information and ballot issuance in the State Voter Registration System.
- (20) We oppose electronic and NGO (Non-Government Organization) involvement in election processes and reporting. We support paper ballots to hand-mark selections on the ballot. We support hand-counting of votes for all races that involve more than one candidate and on all referendums on the ballots. We support paper-only poll books. We do not support electronic tabulators or electronic poll pads. We support locally stored Election Judges’ personal data; we

do not support NGO access to Election Judges' personal data. [Section 9 – Advocate for Fair Election Process]

➤ Section 10 - Defend America Home and Abroad

- (21) Minnesotan's tax dollars may only be spent to benefit U.S. Citizens or individuals who are residents of our country and state on a legal basis. We call for immediate repeal of any bill directing tax dollars to help illegal immigrants, such as driver's licenses for all, the extension of Minnesota Care for illegal immigrants, free college, etc. [Section 10 – Protect our Borders]
- (22) We firmly oppose handing over American federal or state sovereignty to any international organization, such as the W.H.O. or the U.N. [Section 10 – Support International Relations]
- (23) We prohibit foreign entities from owning property and/or any resources on American soil that have been determined to have hostile intent by the United States Government.

➤ Other

- (24) The MN State Republican Party shall facilitate regular contact among the various BPOU's.
- (25) Any candidate seeking Republican endorsement, who publicly endorses a candidate of another party's endorsed candidate, shall be ineligible from seeking future Republican endorsements.
